First vending machine approved by HSA to supply P-meds.

Patients may browse a range of P-meds and GSL items.

A teleconsultation session will be held remotely to allow pharmacist on duty to assess the suitability of medications and approve sales of P-Meds.

Payment may be made via cashless means (NETS, Visætc).

Cameras placed in strategic areas in the machine allow the pharmacist to verify medications remotely before approving collection.

Developed safety feature whereby pharmacist can intervene collection of items by clearing it to the 'uncollected medications' compartment.









